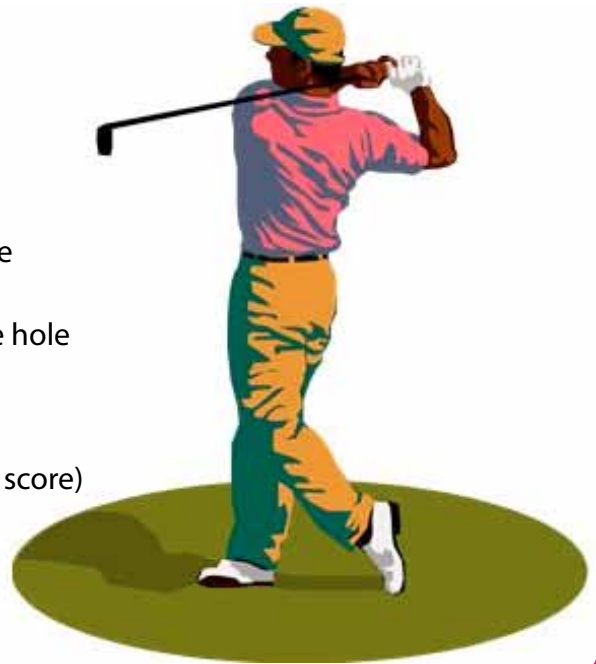


Golf

Did you know? Golf has its own language!

- **par** = the number of shots it should take a skilled player to play one hole
- **hole in one** = it only takes one shot to finish the hole
- **birdie** = one shot under par
- **eagle** = two shots under par
- **albatross** = three shots under par (a very rare score)
- **bogey** = one shot over par
