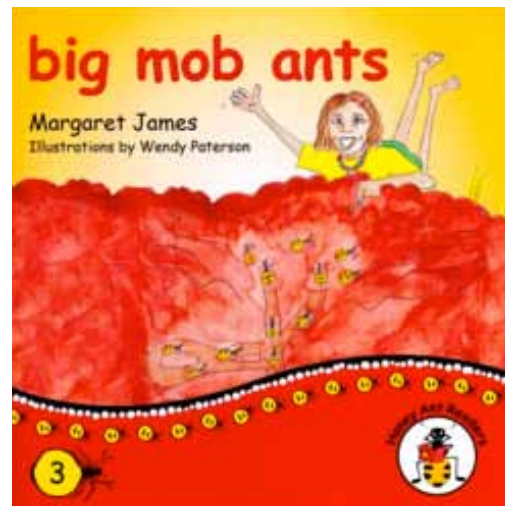


Honey Ant Readers
